World-Class Cancer Research Facility

Complex Mechanical and Electrical Systems



Guttman & Blaevoet provided commissioning services for the new research laboratory building at the Mission Bay Campus. This facility will house researchers who study brain and prostate cancer, as well as members of the Cancer Research Institute and cancer researchers in the population sciences. The building contains offices, a large open atrium with smoke evacuation system, open research labs, support spaces, cold rooms, an MRI room, and a vivarium. Among our commissioning services are development of owner project requirements, design review, commissioning plan, commissioning specifications, functional performance tests, and systems O&M training. Commissioning for all building systems includes such specialty systems as laboratory room-pressure controls, lab equipment, laboratory gases, pure water systems, and radiant cooling and heating systems. Our commissioning services started in 2007 and were completed in 2009.
